Picking Corn in the Corn Field

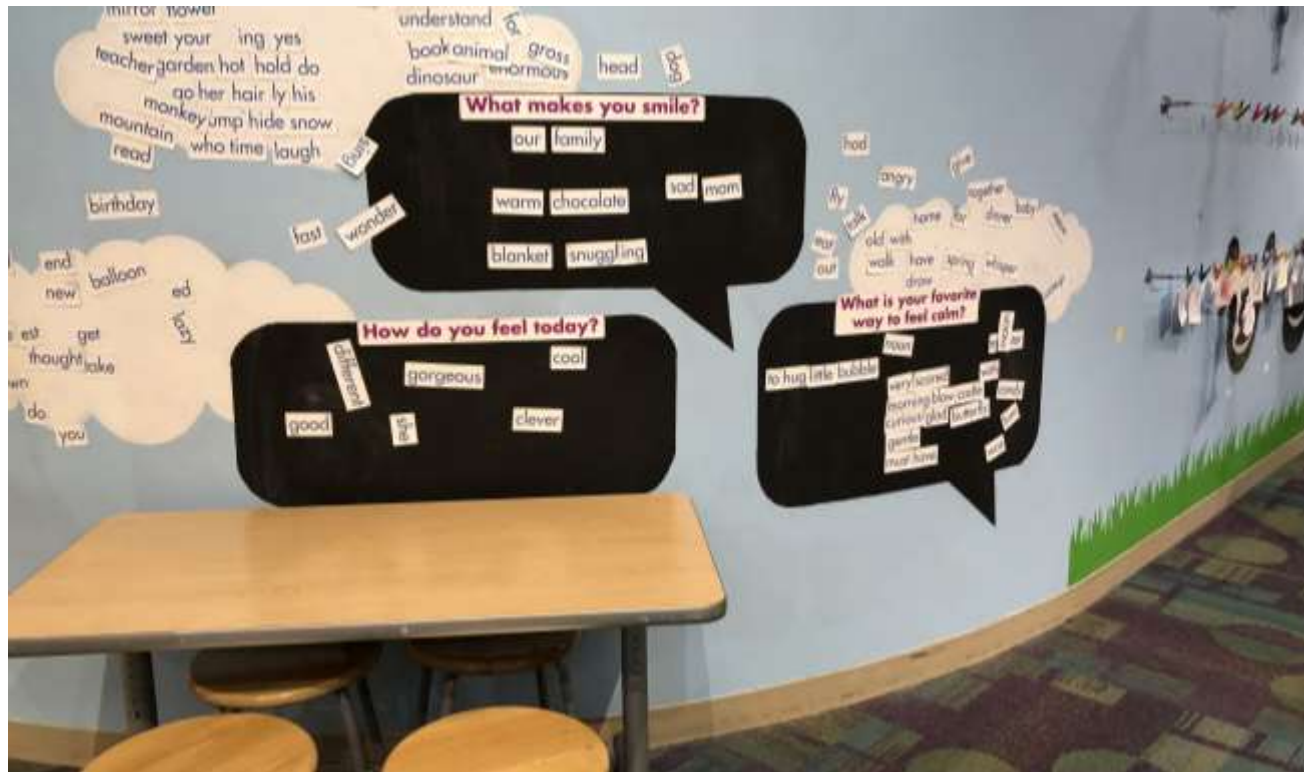


After Hugo and G.G. finished the wall, Hugo saw a field of pretend corn. He picked the corn from the stalks and filled up a basket of corn.

Hugo Visits the Room from Goodnight Moon

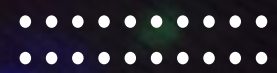

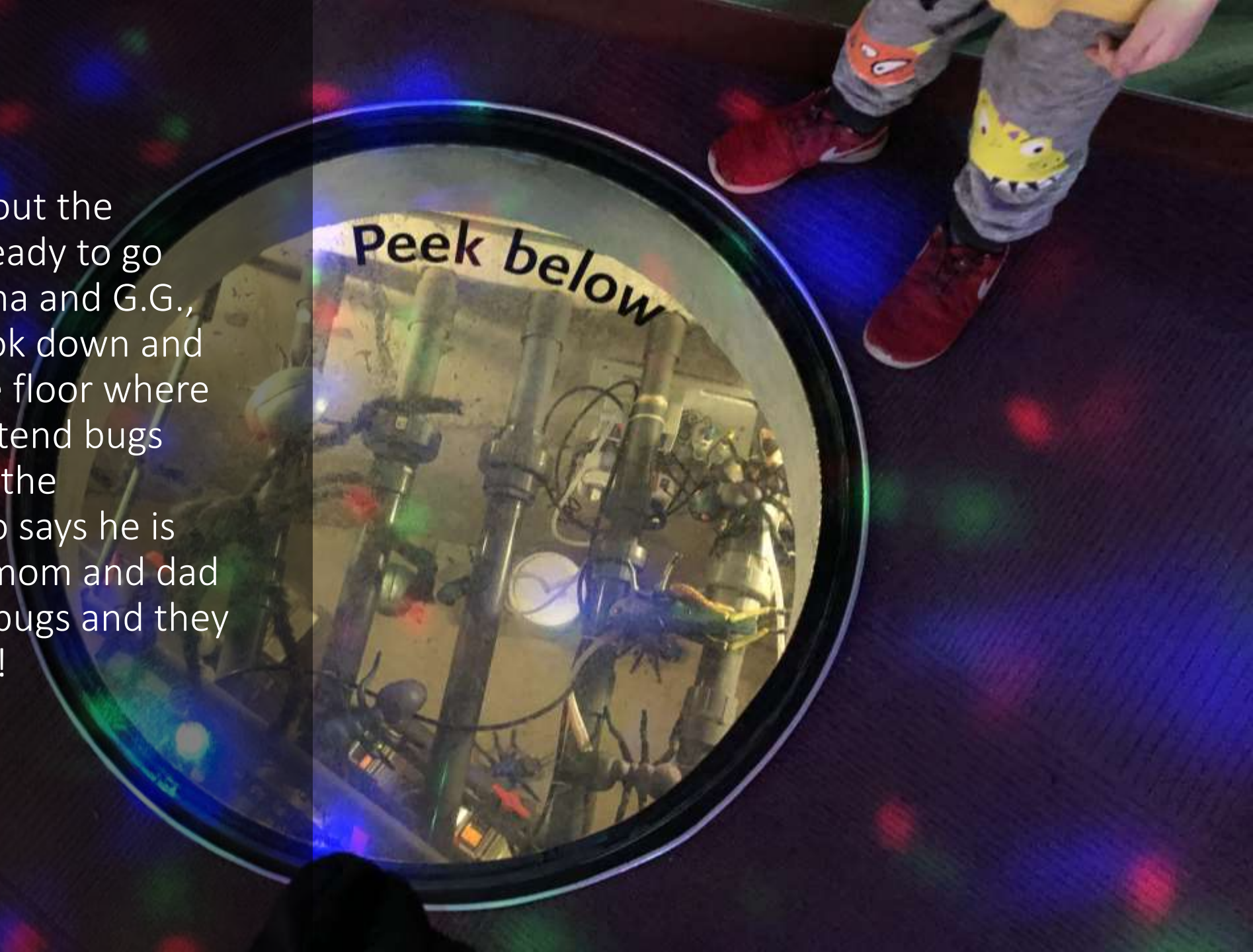
Hugo finds a Drum
